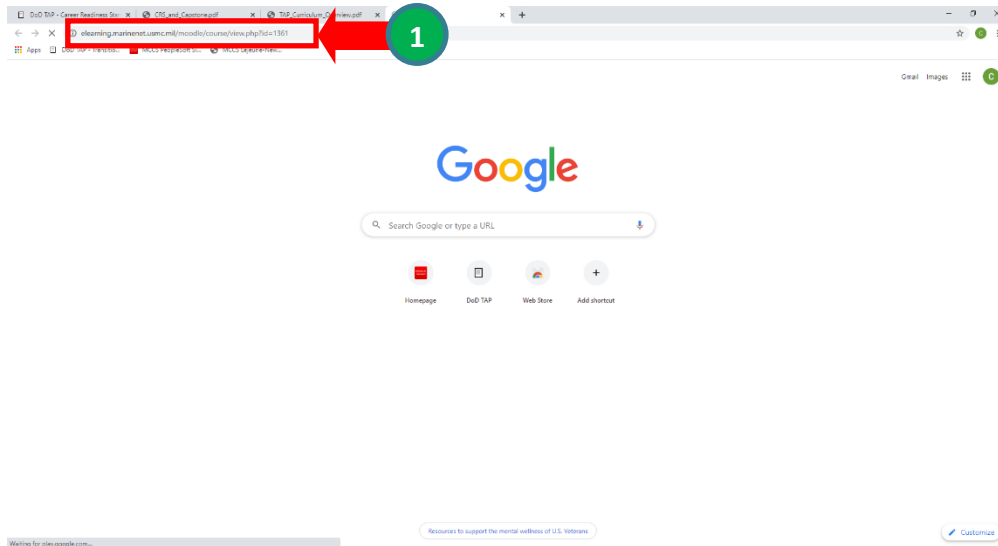


Virtual Reserve Opportunities and Obligations Brief (ROOB)

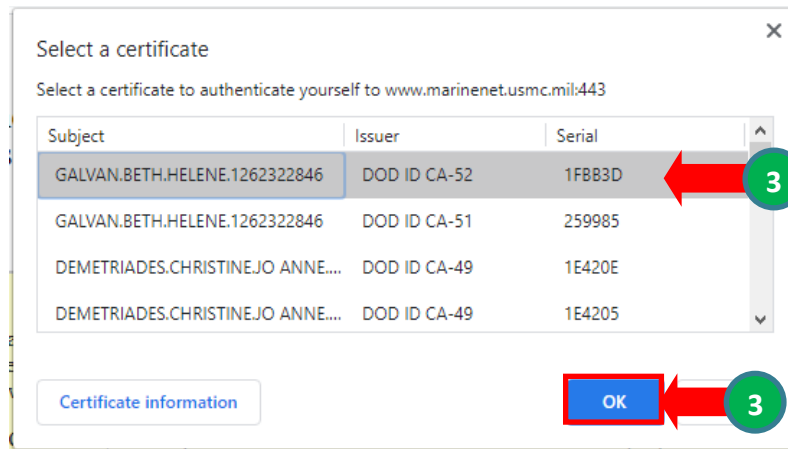

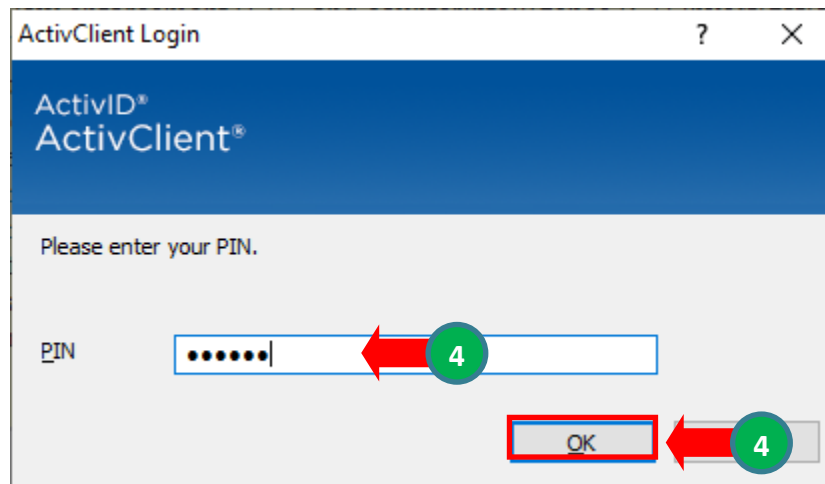




2. Read the warning and click on the  button.

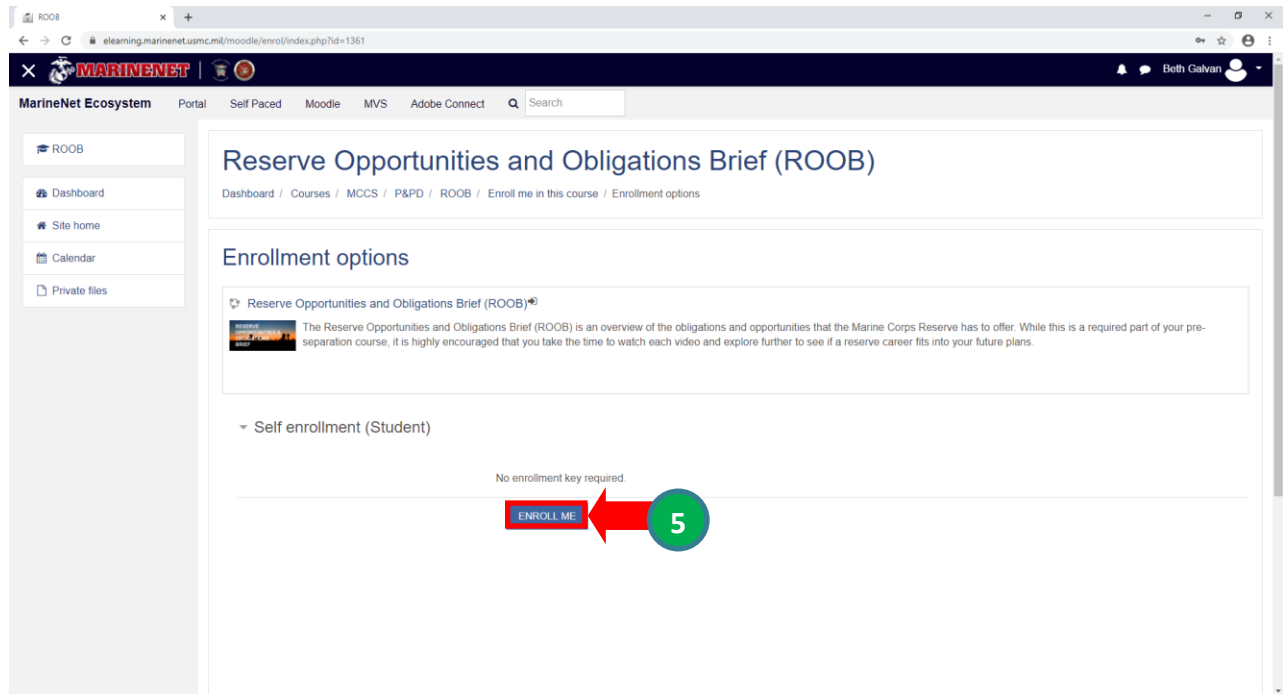


3. Select your authentication certificate and click on the  button.

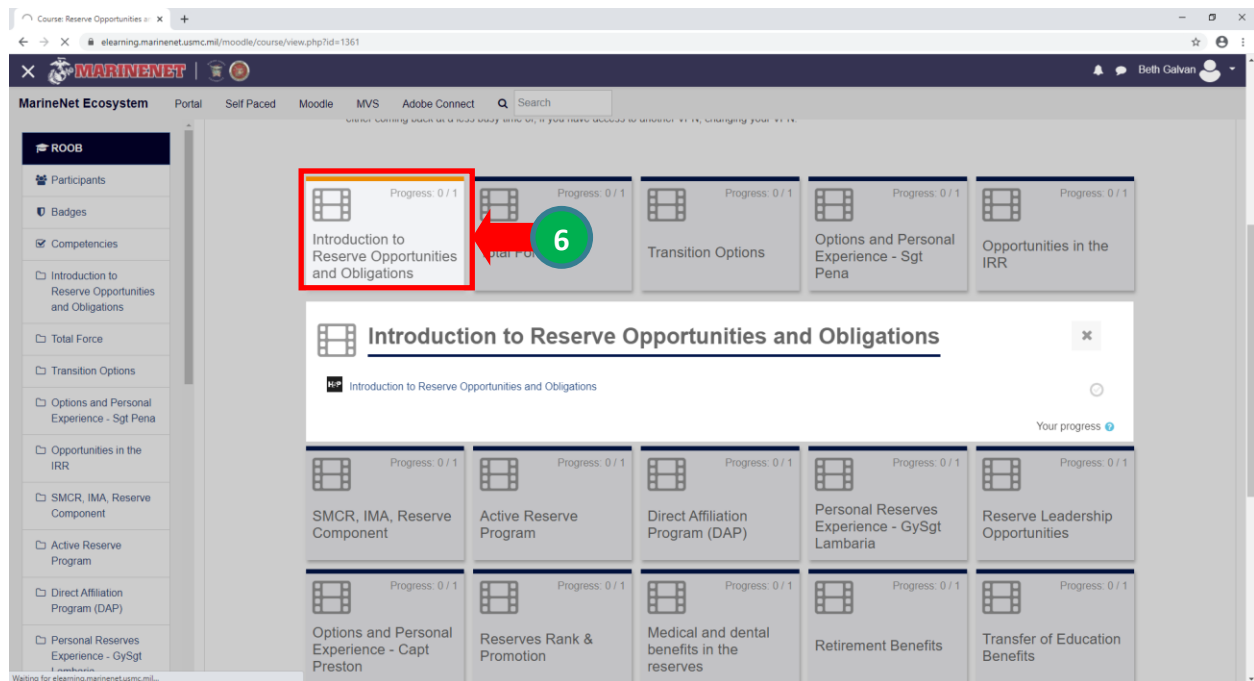


4. Type your PIN and click on the  button.
